Concord Library to close during three-week restroom renovation

The Contra Costa County Library and the City of Concord have approved a three-week closure to accommodate a long-needed restroom renovation project at the community library at 2900 Salvio Street. The Library will close from Sunday, May 6 through Monday, May 28 and will resume regular hours of operation on Tuesday, May 29.

The City of Concord is funding the restroom upgrades which will include new walls, floor tile, trim, fixtures, and paint. These are much needed renovations that will make using the Library a more enjoyable experience for all.

The book drop will not be open during the closure. Library books and materials should be returned to other Contra Costa County Libraries. Link+ will also not be available during the closure. Patrons can use neighboring libraries like Pleasant Hill or Clayton to request holds.

“We are thankful to the City of Concord for making these improvements a priority,” said County Librarian Melinda Cervantes. “We have enjoyed a long and successful partnership with the city and appreciate their support of library services.”
